One nonrenewable \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a first-year college or vocational school student in Iowa. The funds are deposited with the college or vocational school in the student's account and dispersed according to the rules set forth by the college or vocational school for handling scholarship funds. The award is funded by donations from the Iowa State Association, NALC branches, auxiliaries and individuals.

ELIGIBILITY: Applicant must be the son, daughter or legally adopted stepchild of an active, retired, or deceased letter carrier NALC member from a branch in the state of Iowa. If applicant's parent is active, they must be a member in good standing at least one year prior to making application. Applicant must be a high school senior when making application.

REQUIREMENTS: After receiving the accompanying notice (**must be postmarked by 1/15/2026**) the scholarship committee will send the applicant instructions further explaining the scholarship program.

The instructions will include the requirements that all applicants must take the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) or the American College Testing Program (ACT) by their senior year and submit the results to the scholarship committee along with their high school transcript, an essay written by the applicant, and a letter of recommendation from a high school educator.

Information, essay and letter of recommendation will be due by April 15th, 2026.
